Dijon's Cité Internationale Centre for Gastronomy and Wine shares and promotes the values of the 'Gastronomic meal of the French' and the 'Climats, terroirs of Burgundy', which enjoy UNESCO World Heritage status.

Inhabiting the site where the *Hôpital Général* once stood and just a stone's throw from Dijon's old town, the Cité is a striking new setting that celebrates modern architecture whilst safeguarding local heritage. Today, it resonates as a place that encourages people to engage around food, shining a light on local produce and fostering the transmission of skills and knowledge.

The Cité offers something for absolutely everyone, inviting visitors to broaden their knowledge by exploring the major exhibitions, take cookery and wine-tasting courses, attend masterclasses or conferences, enjoy shopping in specialised food and drink shops that place local produce centre stage, indulge their taste buds in the restaurants, or even watch a film at the cinema complex.

The pick-and-mix-style offering caters to visitors young and old, from curious sightseers to consummate connoisseurs, all keen to embrace a thoroughly unique sociable and festive experience.

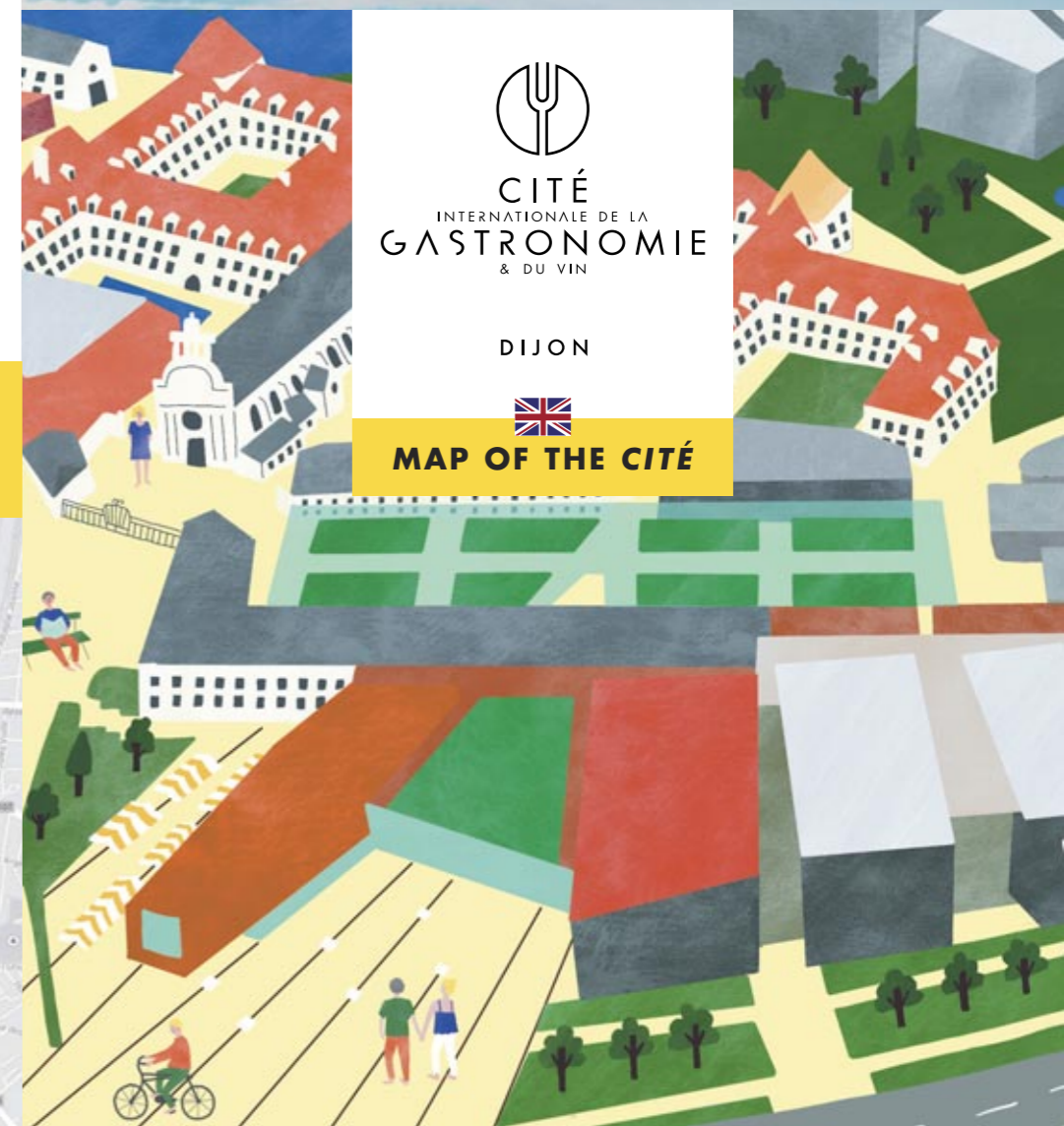
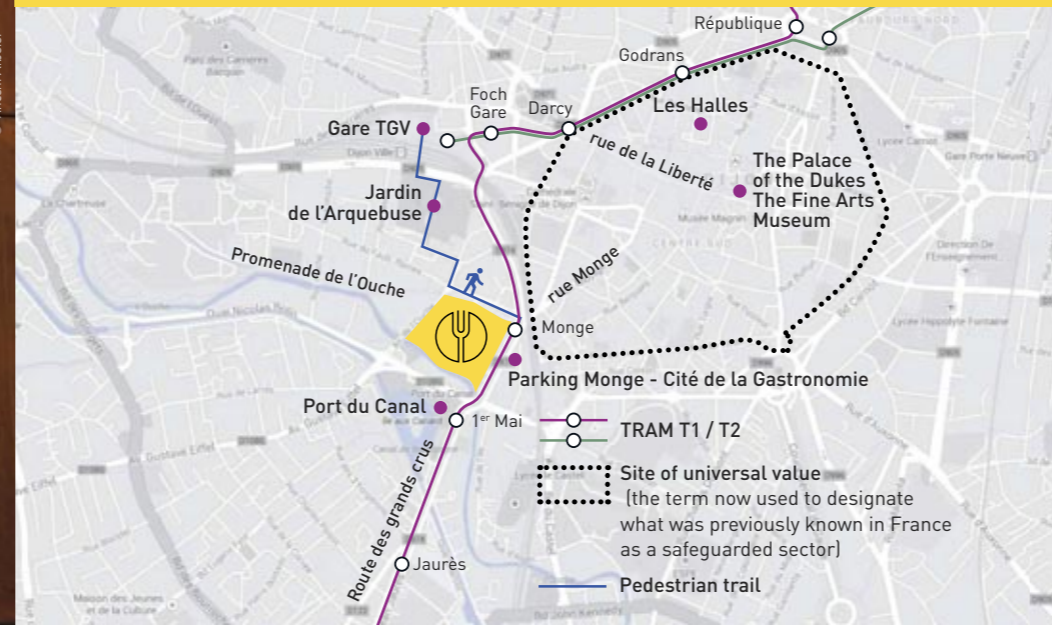

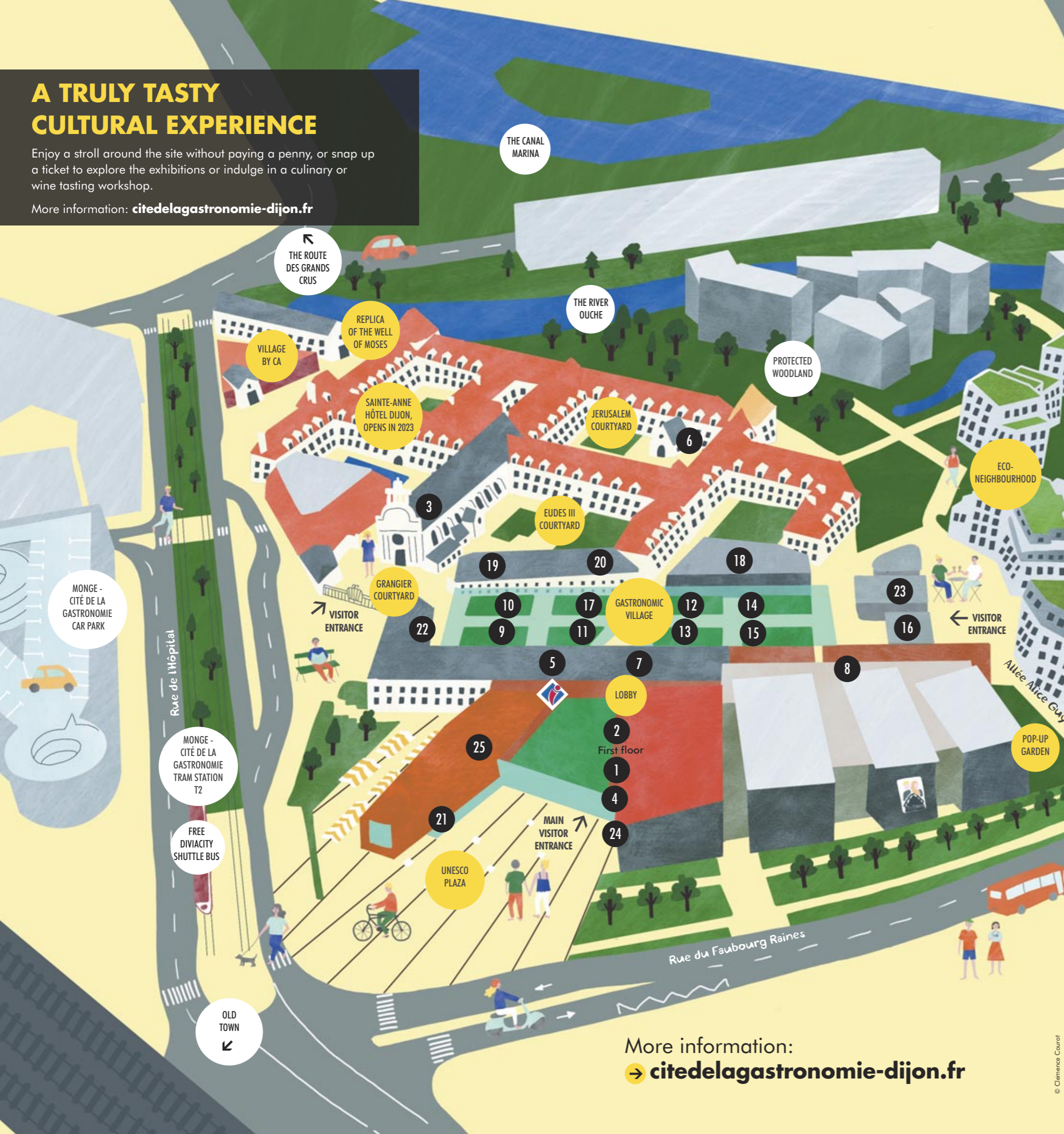
Arriving at the Cité by car? Enjoy reduced-price parking

3 permanent exhibitions and 1 temporary exhibition

- The little theatre of fine food and drink**
Dive deep into the world of French gastronomy, exploring the dining experiences that mark key moments in French people's lives. Take a closer look at the importance of tableware and the characteristic vocabulary capturing the exuberance that so often surrounds French food.
- In the kitchen (first floor)**
Stimulate all 5 senses whilst wending your way across this experimental and interactive stage. On reaching the end of the exhibit, test your skills with "Panic in the kitchen", our exciting digital game that invites you to try and rustle up some traditional French and Burgundy dishes in a limited time.
- The chapel of the Climats and terroirs**
Head off to explore the Climats, terroirs of Burgundy and celebrate the region's rich heritage that turns the spotlight on wine and food.
- Far from a piece of cake!**
Sponsored by Pierre Hermé, the inventor of French-style "haute pâtisserie", this temporary exhibition explores exactly what it is that makes French pastry so special and the envy of the rest of the world. Prepare to step inside a mouth-watering world of pure indulgence.

ARCHITECTURE AND HERITAGE (free admission)

- The 1204, Dijon's Interpretation Centre for Architecture and Heritage**
Immerse yourself in Dijon's rich historic past as well as its contemporary heritage. Explore the city's rich 2,000 year history at your own pace or as part of a guided tour or workshop, all totally free of charge.
- The Sainte-Croix-de-Jérusalem chapel**
Dating back to 1459 and hidden away from prying eyes in one of the inner courtyards, this ancient jewel in Dijon's crown is the only part of the medieval hospital that still remains standing to this day.

A one-of-a-kind wine cellar stocked with 3,000 different wines from all around the world and 250 wines available by the glass.
- The Cave à manger** food cellar, serving a selection of fresh fare and fine delicatessen produce, all hand-picked and expertly prepared by acclaimed chefs from across France.
- Le Comptoir de la Cité**, local and seasonal bistro fare. Food is served at the bar or on the terrace, and can also be purchased to take away.
