This is where the Route des Grands Crus begins as well as the Vallée de la Gastronomie - France.

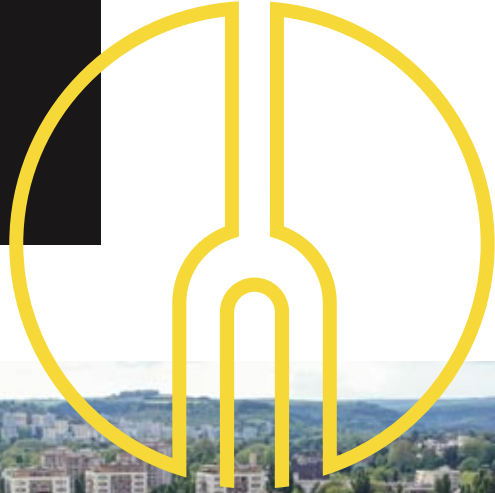
You're just a stone's throw away from the historic centre, immersed within a site of remarkable architecture that pays a glorious tribute to gastronomy and wine.

It's a historic site

Dijon's Cifé Internationale Centre for Gastronomy and Wine, a facility of outstanding architecture and heritage, extends into the site of the old Dijon hospital, the first traces of which date back more than 800 years. It hence returns to their former glory buildings and architectural features that are protected as officially-listed historical or remarkable monuments.

The chapel of Climats and Terroirs, the medieval Sainte-Croix de Jérusalem chapel, a replica of the Well of Moses, the 1204 (architecture and heritage interpretive centre) and more...



It's easy to reach

Dijon's Cifé Internationale Centre for Gastronomy and Wine is just a 5-minute tram ride from the TGV train station. You can also reach it by crossing the Jardin de l'Arquebuse, winding your way through the park on a trail with a “grape varieties and flavours” theme.

You may decide to immerse yourself even deeper in the capital of taste and the art of living by visiting the historic centre just a stone's throw away.

A few suggestions for your day at the Cité

- If you arrive around 10am, start with a free tour of the two chapels, Chapelle des Climats and Chapelle Sainte-Croix de Jérusalem.
- Then join the gourmet guided tour of the good-food-and-drink exhibition entitled Le Petit Théâtre du Bien Manger et du Bien Boire.
- Your tour will end with a tasting of delicious local products in the boutiques of the Gastronomy Village.
- It'll then be time to head for the Cave de la Cité to taste a few wines from the 250 available by the glass, unless of course you prefer a local fruit juice.
- For lunch, take your pick between Comptoir de la Cité, Bamagotchi, Cuisine Expérientielle (weekends only), the fine-food restaurant La Table des Climats, Charreton or the French-style food court where you can pick and choose your gourmet platter.
- During the afternoon, after popping to the gourmet library to see books galore for all ages, take a self-guided tour of the temporary exhibition.
- Finish off with the En Cuisine exhibition, for an amusing exploration of the sensations that come with the culinary experience of cooking and tasting...





A half-day family outing

- Begin with a gourmet guided tour of one of the exhibitions or a tasting workshop designed for parents and children to enjoy together.
- Continue your visit with a stroll in the aisles of the Gastronomy Village to see boutiques packed with products meticulously selected by “Meilleurs Ouvriers de France” experts.
- Depending on the time of day, you may want to share a platter of charcuterie, fish or cheese, or a selection of ice creams and other treats to be enjoyed in a spirit of togetherness, and a musical atmosphere if you come in the evening.



Relaxing with friends at the end of the day

- Start with an introductory workshop at the Burgundy School of Wine or a tasting session at the Cave de la Cité.
- The dinner & cinema option is ideal if you want to try the Comptoir’s signature set menu before heading for the Pathé to see a film.
- And if you fancy a drink afterwards, Bamaotchi is open until midnight (or 1 am from Thursday to Saturday).



It opens every Sunday too!

If it's brunch you're looking for, the Cité invites you to try Cuisine Expérientielle or Le Comptoir. Remember to book ahead.
